Northwest Park Farmers Market – Regulations 2021



Market regulations are listed below. By signing this document you agree that you have read and understand these statements. Please direct any questions to Neighborhoods and Families at nwpmarket@manchesterct.gov or (860) 647-3089.

- 1. Set-Up:** Set-up must be complete by 4:15 pm. The use of tablecloths or coverings of any kind is discouraged at this time. Once unloaded, vendors should leave their vehicle in their marked parking spot when possible to limit exposure during loading and unloading.
- 2. Staff Designations:** If attending the market with multiple staff, designate one staff person to handle product and one to handle money/tokens/coupons.
- 3. Break-Down:** Break-down should be complete by 8:00 pm. Vendors must dispose of or carry out all trash. Vendors should come prepared with a bottle of sanitizing spray with a 1:9 ratio of water to bleach to disinfect tables during the market and prior to loading them into a vehicle.
- 4. Market Absence:** If you are unable to attend a scheduled market, you **MUST** notify Neighborhoods and Families by Monday at 2:00 pm, the week of the market. Notification is necessary so that our advertising can be accurate.
- 5. Severe Weather:** The Northwest Park Farmers Market will run rain or shine. In the extremely unlikely event that there is severe weather (hurricane, tornado, severe thunderstorm, etc.), cancellation information will be posted on the Northwest Park Farmers Market Facebook page by 10:00 AM on market day and on the Town of Manchester cancellation line at (860) 647-3162. However, should conditions change rapidly; we reserve the right to cancel after the deadline has passed for the safety of our vendors, customers, and staff.
- 6. Non-Transferrable:** Market reservations are **NOT** transferable to others.
- 7. No Reselling:** All products must be grown/made in Connecticut.
- 8. Labeling:** Any produce or products not grown by vendor must be labeled as such.
- 9. Food:** All vendors are responsible for obtaining necessary local & state licenses. All pre-paid food must be made in a licensed kitchen. All food must be grown or made by the vendor.
- 10. Masks & Gloves:** Per Executive Order 7, all vendors must wear gloves and face masks at all times when interacting with customers and/or handling product.
- 11. No Samples:** Per Executive Order 7, no samples of any kind are to be provided.
- 12. Bulk Food Items:** Bulk food items such as produce, baked goods and granolas/mixes are not to be set up for self-service by customers and should, when possible, be pre-packaged for sale.
- 13. Contact-less Payment:** Those vendors who do not accept credit cards should consider using Venmo/Paypal as a form of payment to limit the amount of physical exchange.
- 14. Permits, Licenses & Certificates:** Each individual vendor is responsible for obtaining all permits, licenses, and certificates required by local and state ordinance.

I agree to follow all market rules and all applicable state and town regulations. The Neighborhoods and Families Division of the Department of Leisure, Family and Recreation reserves the right to deny market privileges to any vendor who fails to comply with market rules.
